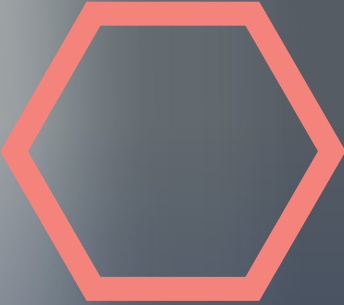

A Word From the Interim CEO

The Gatineau Health Foundation has always been a major partner of the Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) de l'Outaouais. Its impact on our ability to offer the best possible care and services to the population cannot be overemphasized. This year, despite a more difficult economic climate, donors came out in force, enabling the Gatineau Health Foundation to invest more than \$1.2 million in our facilities!

Throughout 2022-2023, the Foundation has supported varied and impactful projects that have had a major positive effect on the organization of our services, but above all on our users. These projects aim to improve the quality, safety and access to care and services, make processes more efficient, optimize our equipment or improve the accessibility of certain services.

For example, the acquisition of specialized medication-checking robots at the pharmacies of the Gatineau and Hull hospitals and at the CHSLD Lionel-Émond aims to improve user safety by minimizing the risk of medication errors. Every day in each facility, up to 2,000 medication checks no longer have to be carried out manually!

The purchase of a biomedical oncology refrigerator in Gatineau directly and tangibly improves the accessibility of medicines to nursing staff, ensuring a faster response and greater efficiency.

The purchase of six polysomnography machines will enable us to carry out over 2,000 additional studies on users suffering from sleep apnoea or respiratory problems.

At the CHSLD Lionel-Émond, the Foundation helped set up and equip a dedicated oral care room in order to optimize the work of dental hygienists and dentists with our residents at the CHSLD Lionel-Émond. A similar initiative will soon be carried out at the CHSLD Ernest-Brisson.

These are just a few of the many examples of how the Gatineau Health Foundation has responded enthusiastically to the needs expressed by our teams and our population over the past year. Its contribution cannot be evaluated solely in terms of financial data or the number of projects supported. It plays an important role in planning the development of our future care, providing invaluable input on the inception of all major new projects.

On behalf of everyone at the CISSS de l'Outaouais, I would like to express my sincere gratitude to the many people involved in the Gatineau Health Foundation. A very special thank you goes out to the donors who, through their gestures, show their confidence in us and share our primary mission: to maintain, improve and restore the health and well-being of the Outaouais population.

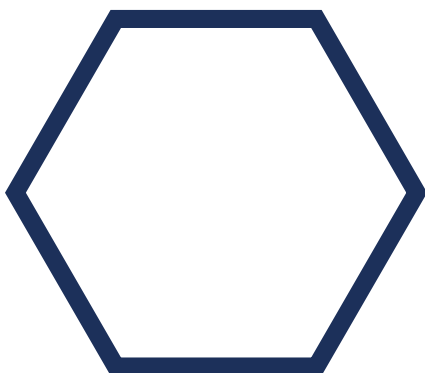

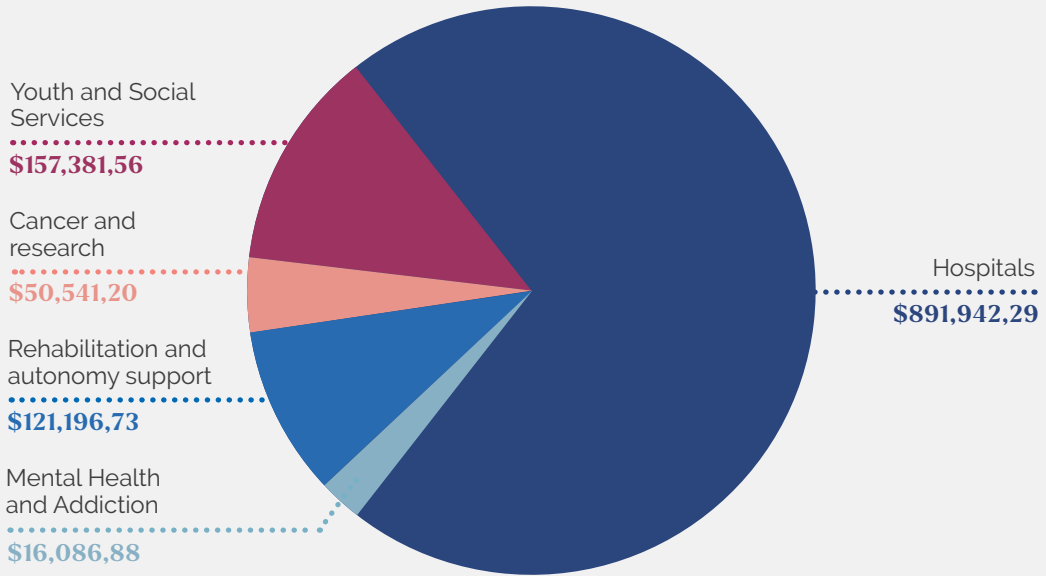

2022-2023 Achievements

The Gatineau Health Foundation is proud to financially support the CISSS de l'Outaouais by fully or partially funding projects and the acquisition of state-of-the-art equipment that have been prioritized by the CISSS de l'Outaouais, with impacts across all areas of activity.

Here are some of this year's highlights.

Hospitals :

AUTOMATED BLOOD SAMPLE ANALYZERS

Every year, the laboratories of the CISSS de l'Outaouais in Gatineau and Hull perform more than 70,000 analytical procedures on blood products. In addition, an average of 25,000 blood products are also used each year for transfusions to patients in our region, including patients suffering trauma or undergoing cancer treatments or surgery.



Previously, the CISSS de l'Outaouais had to analyze these samples manually. The acquisition of two automated analyzers (at the Hull and Gatineau hospitals) means that several samples can be processed simultaneously, new samples can be added during a process without compromising the analyses in progress, the flow of operations is improved by the automation of several tasks, the risk of error linked to manual work that requires several steps is considerably reduced, patient care is accelerated, particularly for urgent cases, and the workload and stress of employees are reduced.

PACVISION

The Gatineau and Hull hospitals' pharmacies and the CHSLD Lionel-Émond each serve more than 200 patients a day, which requires the daily preparation and verification of more than 2,100 units of medication by each hospital.

Given the high throughput in these establishments, it was essential to equip these pharmacies with a PacVision device. This device is based on a pill recognition system that improves quality control and patient safety, whereas before this acquisition, a technician had to manually check everything.



This system offers a number of advantages: free from distractions and fatigue, it ensures constant, rapid and safe checking of the medication bags. It also saves resources, improves traceability and makes the final product much safer. Automated inspection minimizes pharmacist intervention, giving them more time to advise patients, while having a positive effect on the work of nurses, thanks to a strong gain in confidence in the final product.

SERVICE OFFER – POLYSOMNOGRAPH

Regional demand for polysomnography, the most comprehensive and recommended method of examination for assessing sleep-related breathing disorders, is very high. The waiting list in the Outaouais included more than 4,000 patients. Because of the long waiting times, users often turned to the private sector to be examined. As sleep studies are not covered by insurers, they are not financially accessible to everyone.

The aim of this project was to add 6 ambulatory polysomnography machines, making it possible to carry out almost 2,000 additional diagnostic and therapeutic polysomnography examinations, as well as more extensive sleep apnoea diagnoses.

The acquisition of 6 ambulatory polysomnography machines has significantly reduced waiting times for sleep apnoea diagnostic tests and lowered complication risks for patients.





ACQUISITION OF TWO COAGULATION MACHINES

When a patient suffers unexplained bleeding, massive haemorrhage or thrombosis, a blood coagulation test administered using a coagulation analyzer can determine the cause of these abnormalities, which is essential for managing or assessing the risk of excessive bleeding that threatens the patient's life.

The Gatineau and Hull hospitals' laboratories had only one coagulation analyzer each, operating at maximum capacity. If any of this equipment broke down or had to be replaced, samples were sent to another site or other laboratories. This generated additional transport costs, required additional human resources and slowed down diagnoses, which could prove detrimental to patients.

To compensate for this lack of resources, it was necessary to acquire 2 additional coagulation analyzers for the Gatineau and Hull Hospitals. The acquisition of this equipment will go a long way towards improving the turnaround time for results, allowing greater fluidity in the departments, improving response time for analyses, avoiding excessive handling of specimens and reducing the risk of error.

SYRINGE PUMP & INFUSION DEVICE FOR ANAESTHESIA

Anaesthesia techniques have changed considerably in recent years. The practice of TIVA (total intravenous anaesthesia) is playing an increasingly important role in the day-to-day activities of operating room across all specialties. It is not unusual for teams to use up to 3 different infusions for a single patient, in order to optimize patient comfort and safety. The operating room had 8 pumps, and needed an extra one to ensure optimum efficiency. Adding an extra pump will ensure the comfort and safety of surgical patients, provide them with the best possible anaesthesia, optimize the work of respiratory therapists and anaesthetists, and avoid equipment availability problems.

Supporting Independent Living for the Elderly:

DENTISTRY ROOM

Since 2019, the Ministère de la Santé et des Services sociaux has introduced a new program for oral care in CHSLD nursing homes. To ensure that the services offered are adequate and appropriate, a room has been made available for the dental hygienist and the dentist. However, each visit required the dentist's equipment being transported in, which made it more difficult to offer quality, appropriate and safe care to residents.

To meet the growing oral care needs of residents and to offer them a safe, appropriate and personalized service, the CHSLD wanted to create a dentistry room. Doing so required purchasing some essential equipment.

With the acquisition of this equipment now complete, the newly created dentistry rooms make it easier for residents to access oral care in a safe, adapted and high-quality environment. The equipped rooms also help staff work and treat patients in a preventive manner while meeting ministerial requirements in terms of care.

LIVING WALLS

The common areas in the CHSLD Lionel-Émond and the CHSLD Ernest-Brisson play a major role in the daily lives of residents. In order to make this space a pleasant and stimulating living environment, the Gatineau Health Foundation partnered with the Forget For a Moment Foundation to finance the construction of a "living wall" covered with greenery and flowers in these areas.



Praised for its proven beneficial effects, this original concept helps to make the environment more soothing and welcoming, while offering residents a natural setting all year-round. Numerous studies have shown that people who live in an environment featuring vegetation are more likely to experience the following benefits: reduced psychological and physiological stress, better ability to concentrate, improved mental health and reduced mental fatigue, better performance of cognitive tasks, etc.

PURCHASE OF AUTO-LOCKING ROCKING CHAIRS – CHSLD LA PIETÀ

People living in CHSLD nursing homes often have difficulty moving around and are unfortunately at greater risk of falling. To increase their mobility and reduce the risk of falls and related injuries, so-called "auto-locking" medical chairs were recommended. According to researcher Nancy Watson from the University of Rochester School of Nursing, rocking really does bring peace of mind to elderly people and those suffering from dementia. While it has been shown that a gentle repetitive movement has a calming effect on infants, the same has been proven to be true for an elderly person suffering from emotional distress.

The aim of this project was to finance the purchase of 16 auto-locking rocking chairs of various sizes for the 4 living units at CHSLD La Pietà.

The acquisition of these auto-locking rocking chairs now makes it possible to improve patients' mobility and reduce the risk of injuries due to falls, bring peace of mind to elderly people and those suffering from dementia, improve balance and blood circulation, decrease muscular pain, and reduce anxiety and depression.

Oncology :

REQUEST FOR A BIOMEDICAL REFRIGERATOR FOR ONCOLOGY MEDICATION

Some treatments at the Gatineau Hospital Cancer Centre have to be refrigerated. Prior to this acquisition, those treatments had to be taken out of the fridge by the pharmacist and given to the nurse once the patient was settled in, resulting in a daily loss of time and delayed administering of the medication.

What's more, certain specialized medicines that were already ready for use in the event of an allergic reaction were only available in the oncology pharmacy's refrigerator, which was inaccessible to the nurses after opening hours. In the event of an allergic reaction after the

pharmacy's closing, nurses had to prepare the medication themselves, which had an impact on the administration of the treatment and the safety of the user.

The addition of a secure biomedical refrigerator for storing medication directly in the treatment room will reduce waiting time for users receiving chemotherapy treatments that need to be refrigerated, increase safety in the event of an allergic reaction and improve productivity for pharmacists and nurses by reducing unnecessary travel and disturbance, as well as reducing distractions and the risk of errors.
